1: Intelligence Quota. a number used to express the apparent relative intelligence of a person: such as

- a. a score determined by one's performance on a standardized intelligence test relative to the average performance of others of the same age
- b. the ratio of the mental age (as reported on a standardized test) to the chronological age multiplied by 100

2: Icon Query. a number used to express the ability to query specific information from an icon: such as

- a. item identification, location, acronym, enumeration, mounting
- b. item image in place on property
